Religious Education Registration Changes for 2011-12

Please note that our procedure for registering for Religious Education is changing this year.

Rather than having 3 weekends to register, we are moving back to a one-time session which will be held on **Wednesday, September 7, 2011, from 6:30 to 8 p.m. in the Church.**

This is for families with children age 3 through 10th grades and also includes registering for First Communion and Confirmation.

A \$25 late fee per family will be assessed for registrations received after October 1, 2011.
