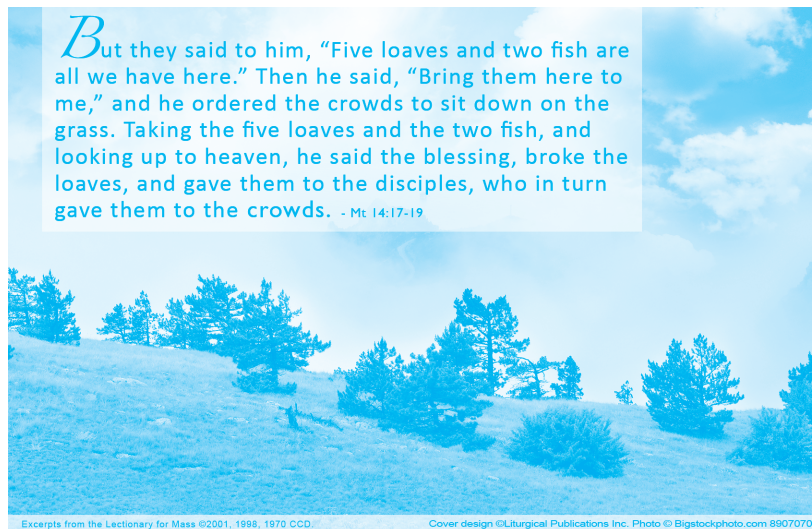

Religious Education Registration Changes for 2011-12

Please note that our procedure for registering for Religious Education is changing this year.

Rather than having 3 weekends to register, we are moving back to a one-time session which will be held on **Wednesday, September 7, 2011, from 6:30 p.m.—8:00 p.m.** in the gym (or the Church if renovation of the gym isn't finished) for families with children ages 3 through 10th grades. This also includes registering for First Communion and Confirmation.

Please help by bringing non-perishable food donations as well as toiletry, laundry and paper products for PRISM, our local food shelf.
