

CELL PHONE POLICY 2010-11
For Students in 4th Grade through 10th Grade

The time students spend at St. Mary's on Wednesdays deserves the respect and courtesy expected in our sanctuary during the Holy Mass.

Cellular phones and other personal electronic devices shall be turned off and kept out of sight during instructional, devotional or service time during weekly Religious Education Classes. Students shall not use any electronic device that in any way disrupts or detracts from our educational and sacred environments. Use of cellular phones or other personal electronic devices is prohibited in classrooms, hallways and the sanctuary during scheduled class times. Students will not be allowed to leave class to respond to any electronic devices.

Students will receive a warning from the catechist, assistant catechist or program director to turn off the device. The device will then be confiscated and returned at the end of class time. After three violations of this policy, the device will be taken and can be retrieved by the family following a personal (student and parent/s) meeting with Father Curt (scheduled at his convenience).
